15A NCAC 11 .0314 of the North Carolina Regulations for Protection Against Radiation establishes a general license authorizing physicians, clinical laboratories and hospitals to possess certain small quantities of radioactive materials for in vitro clinical or laboratory tests not involving the internal or external administration of the radioactive material or the radiation therefrom to human beings or animals. Possession of radioactive material under 15A NCAC 11 .0314 is not authorized until the physician, clinical laboratory, or hospital has completed this application and received from the agency a validated copy of this application with registration number.

- b. The registrant has appropriate radiation measuring instruments to carry out the tests for which radioactive material will be used under the general license of 15A NCAC 11 .0314. These tests will be performed only by personnel competent in the use of the instruments and in the handling of the radioactive material.
- c. I understand that North Carolina Regulations require that any change in the information furnished by a registrant on this registration certificate be reported in the Radioactive Materials Branch within thirty (30) days from the effective date of such change;
- d. I have read and understood the provisions of 15A NCAC 11 .0314 of the North Carolina Regulations for Protection Against Radiation; and, I understand that the registrant is required to comply with those provisions as all radioactive material which he receives, acquires, possesses, uses or transfers under the general license for which this Registration Certificate is filed with the North Carolina of Environment and Natural Resources.
